

Dorchester Poppy Trail Project

The Town Council is co-ordinating an exciting project, as a part of the 100 year WW1 commemorations, to create a 'Dorchester Poppy Trail'. The trail will highlight sites of significant interest in the town by way of information boards or a poppy plaque. There will also be an accompanying leaflet in paper form and downloadable.

The project is looking to appoint a Researcher / Writer and Editor who will be responsible for guiding the research being carried out by project volunteers and to write engaging texts for the information boards. It is anticipated that the person appointed would also deliver interpretation training for all project volunteers etc.

The project also requires a Designer to work with the Researcher in the production of the information boards and trail leaflet and with the manufacturing company to produce the information boards.

It is anticipated that the following fees will apply:-

Researcher - £1,500

Trainer – £375

Designer - £2,300
